## RULES & CONDITIONS:

1. The show is run in accordance with the byelaws of the Dartmoor Pony Society, as amended/updated by Council.
2. No Member/Competitor/Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony in a class where the Judge has owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced that pony or where the pony has been owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced by the Judge's immediate family (husband, wife, parents, children, brother or sister) partner, employer or employee. An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced, broken or trained an equine since 1<sup>st</sup> October in the previous year.
3. Please note that all ponies must be **PURE BRED DARTMOOR** ponies registered in the main body of the Dartmoor Pony Society Stud Book or SR1 or SR2 registered ponies & the **correct registration number MUST be quoted on the entry form.**
4. Be aware that the maximum height of a Dartmoor Pony is 127cms where this differs from qualifying class descriptions.
- 4a. Owners **MUST** be members of the Dartmoor Pony Society to receive a DPS rosette **& must produce their current membership card at the time of the award.** The Owner is the person in whose name the pony is registered in with the DPS office.
5. Rules of the Dartmoor Pony Society must be adhered to by **all** competitors. Rules are on the Dartmoor Pony Society website (<http://www.dartmoorponysociety.com/shows>) and will be available on the day in the Secretary's tent.
5. **Entry Fees: Members - £10 per class. Foal Classes £5. Non-members - £15 per class**
6. Prize Money: 1<sup>st</sup> £10, 2<sup>nd</sup> £6, 3<sup>rd</sup> £4 Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place. **NB All prize money to be collected on the day.**
7. All stallions & colts three years old & over must be in possession of a DPS Veterinary Licence. All riders of stallions **MUST** have attained their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year in order to compete in all classes. All handlers of stallions & colts **MUST** have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
8. Stallion Bridle Markers: ALL ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker, and it is advisable that in hand stallions and young colts display them. These are available from the NPS and other societies.
9. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications **MUST** be worn at all times when mounted and also by competitors in Young Handler classes: All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard is also accepted to the list.
10. No spurs to be worn at any time.
11. No ponies may be coralled anywhere on the show field. It is not advisable to tie a pony to the outside of a trailer, wagon or any other structure unless attended by an adult at all times.
12. SAE to be provided with entries for back numbers to be posted.
13. The Northern Dartmoor Pony Show & its officials do not hold themselves responsible in any way for any loss, injury or damage to any persons, animals or property in connection with the show. Each exhibitor is asked to pay £3 towards the costs of paramedics on the show field.
14. The owner/handler of any animal deemed to be out of control may be asked to remove the animal from the showground.
15. **TROPHIES:** All trophies are the property of the NDPS and where awarded they **MUST** be returned when requested in a **CLEAN & UNDAMAGED** condition to a committee member. Any trophies being returned on show day **by prior arrangement** must be with the secretary by **8.30am. Trophies will only be awarded to DPS members.**
16. Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class & at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50. If on investigation by the committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited.
17. **Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.**

### RULES FOR CLASS 14

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year (**NB: Please note any results from 2020 are exempt**), it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year). **2020 is excluded when calculating consecutive years.**
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

1. Open to exhibitors who have not exhibited at NDPS within the last 3 years, but may have exhibited at other Dartmoor breed shows.

### **Class 25 NDPS Tiny Tots WHP**

Open to pure bred Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but must not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

Ponies are to be on a lead rein. (No fillers).

**NCPA Qualifier**

### **Class 26 The NPS/Stevenson Brothers Rocking Horse First Ridden WHP National Championship/Equifest**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor mares or geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must have attained their 5th birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Riders who have qualified for the (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) M&M Working Hunter Pony Championship before the 1st January in the current year are not eligible. The three highest placed ponies, in each class go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

**NCPA Qualifier**

### **Class 27 NPS/TEAM MURPHY M&M Junior Working Hunter Pony National Championship**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. The three highest placed ponies, in each class go forward to the final. Where these ponies have already qualified the pony standing next in line, which has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification goes no lower than fifth place.

### **Class 28 NPS/NAF M&M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship**

**NCPA Qualifier**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year (NB: Please note any results from 2020 are exempt), it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated M&M WHP class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Open M&M WHP classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year). 2020 is excluded when calculating consecutive years.
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately denoviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final.

### **Class 29 NPS/AREA 5 M&M Intermediate Working Hunter Pony National Championship**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over. Ponies never to have qualified for the NPS M&M Working Hunter Pony (Horse of the Year Show/RIHS) finals before 1st January in the current year. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over.

## **QUALIFIER INFORMATION**

### **BSPS -**

Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor ponies 4 years old & over, riders any age. Kindly sponsored by Le Mieux. The 1st & 2nd prizewinners from the class will qualify for the semi final to be held at the BSPS Heritage Championship Show at Arena UK. One judge may be appointed but the marking system must be used for the qualifying rounds. To be judged on a 50/50 marks system. 50 marks for Show/Freedom of action, and 50 marks for conformation & breed type. Ponies, Owners and Riders need not be B.S.P.S. Members to compete in the Liverpool Breed Semi-Final qualifying classes but pony, owner and rider will need to register to compete in the SEMI-FINAL to be held at the B.S.P.S. "Heritage" Championship Show. Classes will be judged under B.S.P.S. rules as per the 2021 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards. Competitors competing in BSPS classes must only use tack permissible in BSPS classes on the showground whilst mounted & are subject to the rules of BSPS whether members or not.

BSPS Classic Services Group Challenge – The show is a squalifier for the BSPS Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must NOT have qualified for the 2021 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class.

### **BSPS 2B -**

BSPS 2B - This is a Points Show for BSPS 2B (Heritage Dartmoors).

### **NPS –**

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

The highest placed pony, , in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a **white arm band** in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, , are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships, Breed Show Rules : These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become a Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony,. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

### **NPS Area 4**

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders In Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by "M P GLOSS PRODUCTS UK LTD". The Champion and Reserve from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland In Hand will qualify for the Final to be held on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021 at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

### **Equifest**

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> August 2021. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

### **NDPS –**

Joan Petherbridge Championships kindly sponsored in her memory by June & Peter Lloyd.

Open to exhibitors who have not exhibited at NDPS within the last 3 years, but may have exhibited at other Dartmoor breed shows.

### **NCPA**

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show in September 2021. First and second prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify.
