RULES & CONDITIONS:

- 1. The show is run in accordance with the byelaws of the Dartmoor Pony Society, as amended/updated by Council.
- 2. No Member/Competitor/Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony in a class where the Judge has owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced that pony or where the pony has been owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced by the Judge's immediate family (husband, wife, parents, children, brother or sister) partner, employer or employee. An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced, broken or trained an equine since 1st October in the previous year.
- 3. Please note that all ponies must be PURE BRED DARTMOOR ponies registered in the main body of the Dartmoor Pony Society Stud Book or SR1 or SR2 registered ponies & the correct registration number MUST be quoted on the entry form.
- 4. Be aware that the maximum height of a Dartmoor Pony is 127cms where this differs from qualifying class descriptions.
- 5. Owners MUST be members of the Dartmoor Pony Society to receive a DPS rosette & must produce their current membership card at the time of the award. The Owner is the person whose name the pony is registered in with the DPS office.
- 6. Rules of the Dartmoor Pony Society must be adhered to by <u>all</u> competitors. Rules are on the Dartmoor Pony Society website (http://www.dartmoorponysociety.com/shows) and will be available on the day in the Secretary's tent.
- 7. Upon entering this show, all exhibitors understand that the organisers of the event, landowners, officials, and The Dartmoor Pony Society accept no liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors entering this show must be covered for third party liability insurance. This can either be in the form of a personal policy or through membership of an organisation that provides cover, such as the BHS.
- 8. Entry Fees: DPS Members £10 per class. Foal Classes £5. Non-members £15 per class. JP classes free to enter as long as the pony is entered in another class.
- 9. Prize Money: 1st £10, 2nd £6, 3rd £4. Rosettes to 6th place. NB All prize money to be collected on the day.
- 10. All stallions & colts three years old & over must be in possession of a DPS Veterinary Licence. All riders of stallions MUST have attained their 11th birthday by the 1st January in the current year in order to compete in all classes. All handlers of stallions & colts must have attained their 14th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.
- 11. Stallion Bridle Markers: ALL ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker, and it is advisable that in hand stallions and young colts display them. These are available from the NPS and other societies.
- 12. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn at all times when mounted and also by competitors in Young Handler classes: PAS 015 2011; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)
- 13. No spurs to be worn at any time.
- 14. No ponies may be corralled anywhere on the show field. It is not advisable to tie a pony to the outside of a trailer, wagon or any other structure unless always attended by an adult.
- 15. Back numbers to be collected on the day.
- 16. The Northern Dartmoor Pony Show & its officials do not hold themselves responsible in any way for any loss, injury or damage to any persons, animals or property in connection with the show. Each exhibitor is asked to pay £3 towards the costs of paramedics on the show field.
- 17. The owner/handler of any animal deemed to be out of control may be asked to remove the animal from the showground.
- 18. TROPHIES: All trophies are the property of the NDPS and where awarded they MUST be returned when requested in a CLEAN & UNDAMAGED condition to a committee member. Any trophies being returned on show day by prior arrangement must be with the secretary by 8.30am. Trophies will only be awarded to DPS members.
- 19. Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class & at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50. If on investigation by the committee the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited.
- 20. Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory minimum requirement for all horses/ponies competing in NPS affiliated classes. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old. This Rule may be subject to change following guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the NPS website.

RULES FOR CLASS 17

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, BSPS Lemieux or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, LIHS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.
- v. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

RULES FOR CLASS 26

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open affiliated M&M WHP class
- ii) Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Open M&M WHP classes
- iii) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv) If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately denoviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final.

RULES FOR JOAN PETHERBRIDGE CLASSES

1. Open to exhibitors who have not exhibited at NDPS within the last 3 years, but may have exhibited at other Dartmoor breed shows.

QUALIFIER INFORMATION

BSPS -

Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor ponies 4 years old & over, riders any age. The 1st & 2nd prizewinners from the class will qualify for the semi final to be held at the BSPS Heritage Championship Show at Arena UK. One judge may be appointed but the marking system must be used for the qualifying rounds. To be judged on a 50/50 marks system. 50 marks for Show/Freedom of action, and 50 marks for conformation & breed type. Ponies, Owners and Riders need not be B.S.P.S. Members to compete in the BSPS Heritage Ridden Supreme semi-final qualifying classes but pony, owner and rider will need to register to compete in the SEMI-FINAL to be held at the B.S.P.S. "Heritage" Championship Show. Classes will be judged under B.S.P.S. rules as per the 2023 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards. Competitors competing in BSPS classes must only use tack permissible in BSPS classes on the showground whilst mounted & are subject to the rules of BSPS whether members or not.

NPS -

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1 st -3 rd August 2023. The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship

Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships, Breed Show Rules:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

NPS Area 4

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders In Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by "MP GLOSS PRODUCTS UK". The Champion and Reserve from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Mountain amp; Moorland In Hand Classes will qualify for the Final to be held on Monday 28th August 2023 at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

Equifest

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 2nd – 5 th August 2023. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

NCPA

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show in September 2023. First and second prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify.

NDPS Top of the North

This championship is open to pure bred ponies that have been bred in the north, are owned by a Northern member and exhibited by a Northern member. Exhibits eligible to compete for this championship will receive a marked competitor number indicating that the exhibitor should wear a green armband in their classes, and also in the championship. The highest place exhibit in each class, whose handler/rider is wearing a green armband, will be entitled to go forward to the Top of the North Championship. If eligible, you will be given a card by the steward in your class.

For this show, the definition of 'North' is as follows: Scotland, Northumberland, Cumbria, Tyne & Wear, Durham, North Yorkshire, Lancashire, West Yorkshire, East Yorkshire, Merseyside, Greater Manchester, South Yorkshire, Cheshire, Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire, Lincolnshire, Isle of Man & Northern Ireland.

Eligible exhibitors should wear a green armband in their in-hand classes and also in the championship.
